Mayor Miller to address Senate Committee on Bill C-10

The Mayor was to officiate at the FILMPORT event on June 5th, but has been asked by the mayors of other Canadian cities to lead a delegation against legislation that threatens to censor film production nation-wide.

FILMPORT applauds the Mayor's actions in speaking out on behalf of the film industry. Mayor Miller has been a staunch supporter of FILMPORT and we couldn't imagine cutting the ribbon without him.

TEDCO and FILMPORT are working with the Mayor's office to arrange an alternative date for the ceremony. New invitations will be sent out when the date has been confirmed.
